

# High Desert Trails 2017

## Civilian Traffic Plan

Saturday, May 6th, 2017 (Document 4/26/2017)

Every effort was made before the event to contact and notify land-owners and traffic that a closure from **8AM to 8PM** would occur on the day of the event. Land owners were contacted, sent a mailing about the event, and signs were put in place months before the event. We worked with the Friends of Jawbone to notify riders and groups about our event. We worked closely with the Kern County Public Works department who issued our permit. CHP was contracted in accordance with our permit.

### All times on this plan are approximate and could change if we encounter a delay.

- **DETOUR** - Butterbedt Canyon Road SC123 / SC251 Vehicles wishing to travel North to Kelso Valley can use Butterbedt Canyon Road / Gold Canyon Road as it will remain open during the event. Vehicles wishing to travel to the OHV park in Jawbone Canyon from Kelso Valley can use Butterbedt Canyon Road SC123 / SC251 to access the park.
- **GREEN LIGHT** - One of the sweep vehicles will be designated with a flashing green light. When this vehicle enters the stage the road behind it is considered open. Any traffic that needs to exit the road may do so by following the green light sweep. Inform the public that the road will be closing again shortly. The amateur radio net will track the public through the stage until they have either reached their destination (say, a mid-stage ranch) or exited the stage at the other end.
- **COURSE OPENING, 000, 00, 0 CAR** - Once any of these vehicles enters the stage, the road is closed and a high speed time trial event has started. Competitor vehicles will follow in **1** minute increments.
- **SPECTATORS** - This is generally not a public or big spectator event. However, participants will make their cars available for public viewing at the Jawbone Canyon Service Area on the morning before the event begins **9:00-10:00AM**.

### CHP @ Jawbone Canyon Road (Stages 1 / 6,7 / 10,11,13) SOUTH END

- Head onto Jawbone Canyon Road from Route 14
- Travel 6.4 miles to where the pavement ends
- Follow Jawbone Canyon Rd. on dirt another 1.8 miles
- 35° 19' 20.63", -118° 6' 26.89" (**35.322397, -118.107469**)

**9:00AM** - Jawbone Canyon Road **closed** to all civilian traffic. (Rally Starts @10AM)  
**to 10:45AM** - Jawbone Canyon Road re-opened for civilian traffic. Follow green light sweep.

**12:15PM** - Jawbone Canyon Road **closed** to all civilian traffic.  
**to 2:45PM** - Jawbone Canyon Road re-opened for civilian traffic. Follow green light sweep.

**3:30PM** - Jawbone Canyon Road **closed** to all civilian traffic.  
**to 6:00PM** - Jawbone Canyon Road re-opened for civilian traffic. Follow green light sweep.

**6:45PM** - Jawbone Canyon Road **closed** to all civilian traffic.  
**to 8:00PM** - Jawbone Canyon Road re-opened for civilian traffic. Follow green light sweep.  
(Rally Finished @8:00PM)

**CHP @ Kelso Valley Road (Stages 2,5, / 12,13) NORTH END**

- Head onto Jawbone Canyon Road from Route 14
- Travel approximately 18 miles on dirt.
- Turn RIGHT onto Kelso Valley Road and continue 7.2 miles.
- Stop at the intersection of Piute Mountain Road.
- 35°28'47.1"N 118°12'45.8"W (**35.479753, -118.212732**)

**9:30AM** - Kelso Valley Road **closed** to all civilian traffic.

**to 11:00AM** - Kelso Valley Road re-opened for civilian traffic. Follow green light sweep.

**11:45PM** - Kelso Valley Road **closed** to all civilian traffic.

**to 1:15PM** - Kelso Valley Road re-opened for civilian traffic. Follow green light sweep.

**5:00PM** - Kelso Valley Road **closed** to all civilian traffic.

**to 7:45PM** - Kelso Valley Road re-opened for civilian traffic. Follow green light sweep.
